An extra early start in fresh and sometimes foggy conditions greeted riders who turned out at Mount Pleasant last Sunday for the final 100km or 200km edition of the 2021 Grand / Mini Slam Challenge Series. Approximately 100 riders saddled up on the day in mostly sunny conditions as they tackled the first 100km loop. Most were content to ride just one 100km loop however 28 riders set themselves the challenge of the full 200km distance. There were, no doubt, several PB efforts on the day.
